

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Request to amend Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 2000-443,
Titled FY 2001 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budgets)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-502

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the**
2 **Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has approved Resolution No. 2000-443 granting the Executive**
4 **Branch authorization to expend for the various programs, which included Individual**
5 **with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the IDEA budget is now being presented to the Legislative Council and the amount**
7 **cited previously shall now read: Individual with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) -**
8 **\$67,600.00 + \$5,732.56 (Est. IDC); and**

9 **WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Resolution No. 2000-443 to correct the amount for**
10 **authorization to expend.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves the amendment of**
12 **Resolution No. 2000-443, correcting the amount to now read: \$67,600.00 + \$5,732.56**
13 **(Est. IDC) and authorizes Executive Branch to expend IDEA funds in accordance with**
14 **attached budgets.**

15 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24TH Day**
16 **of OCTOBER, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,649.55 FOR; 143.25**
17 **AGAINST; 372.7 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
18 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
19 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
20 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
21 **Stat. 984).**


