5		documentation have been subjected to arrest, deportation, seizure of their vehicles
6		and in some cases criminal prosecution; and
7	WHEREAS,	the Executive has negotiated an agreement with the American and Mexican Consuls
8		to waive certain documentary requirements and issue members of the Nation
9		Mexican passports and American visas; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Nation to obtain
11		Mexican passports and American visas for members residing in Mexico.
12	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:
13		1. The sum of \$102,310.00 is hereby appropriated to pay for processing fees and
14		$related\ expenses\ associated\ with\ obtaining\ Mexican\ passports\ and\ American\ visas$
15		for the one thousand two hundred thirty-eight (1,238) members residing in Mexico
16		for whom these documents have not been processed.
17		2. The Executive is authorized and instructed to conduct this activity and expend
18		funds appropriated herein required to obtain passports and visas for the
19		members residing in Mexico.
