

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing FY 2001 Expenditures from the SAWRSA Trust Fund for Continuation of
Efforts to Complete Tribal Responsibilities and Obligations Related to Utilization
of Central Arizona Project Water and Irrigation Systems)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-516

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, by means of Resolution No. 99-334,
2 authorized and directed the completion of tribal responsibilities and obligations
3 related to construction of facilities for utilization of Central Arizona Project water
4 and irrigation systems in the eastern Schuk Toak District; and

5 WHEREAS, the Nation's Water Projects Office developed projections for costs associated with
6 construction and administration efforts totaling \$4,809,941 and requested from the
7 SAWRSA Trust Fund an amount of \$1,599,730 for the second half of FY 1999 and
8 \$4,586,219 for FY 2000; and

9 WHEREAS, portions of work originally identified for FY 2000 were not completed and are now
10 incorporated into FY 2001 as reflected in the attached budget and justification; and

11 WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office submitted the attached budget and justification for FY 2001
12 to continue the scope of work authorized under Resolution No. 99-334 for an amount
13 of \$1,051,458; and

14 WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office requests from the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council,
15 approval of funding from the SAWRSA Trust Fund to enable completion of tribal
16 responsibilities and obligations related to utilization of Central Arizona Project water
17 and irrigation systems in the eastern Schuk Toak District.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
19 approves the funding request and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the
20 scope of work and the attached budget.

21 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that funds in the amount of \$1,051,458 are hereby appropriated from
22 the SAWRSA Trust Fund to cover expenditures during the period from October 01,
23 2000 through March 31, 2001.

24 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27TH Day
25 of OCTOBER, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,941.45 FOR; 160.0
26 AGAINST; 64.05 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
27 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
28 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
29 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
30 Stat. 984).
