

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Acceptance of the Grant Assistance Award No. E-98911601-0 in the amount of**  
**\$15,000.00 carryover funds for continuance of Pesticide Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-529

1 **WHEREAS, Article XVIII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation sets out the Council's**  
2 **continuing responsibility to assure for all members safe and healthful surroundings;**  
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation utilizes pesticides at the tribal farms and hires**  
5 **commercial applicators to apply pesticides within the tribal buildings, community**  
6 **homes, schools, and business establishments; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the EPA Office of Pesticide Program has announced the availability of Cooperative**  
8 **Agreement carryover funds in the amount of \$15,000.00 for continuance of the**  
9 **Pesticide Program under the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the carryover funds would allow the Pesticide Program to continue to assist the**  
11 **Nation by completing the pesticide use assessment, implement the Nation's pesticide**  
12 **ordinance to regulate pesticide use, sale, and distribution and continue to provide**  
13 **educational outreach to community members, farm employees, schools, tribal**  
14 **officials and business entities.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
16 **the acceptance of the EPA carryover fund award for \$15,000.00 for the continuance**  
17 **of the Nation's Pesticide Program.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that the Tohono**  
19 **O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated**  
20 **official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however,**  
21 **that any amendments affecting funding or funding levels of the grant shall be**  
22 **submitted for further prior approval.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves the attached budget and**  
24 **authorizes the expenditures of Pesticide carryover funds according to this budget.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day**  
26 **of NOVEMBER, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,101.45 FOR; 64.05**  
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
31 **Stat. 984).**




