10	WHEREAS,	the carryover funds would allow the Pesticide Program to continue to assist the					
11		Nation by completing the pesticide use assessment, implement the Nation's pesticide					
12		ordinance to regulate pesticide use, sale, and distribution and continue to provide					
13		educational outreach to community members, farm employees, schools, tribal					
14		officials and business entities.					
15	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves					
16		the acceptance of the EPA carryover fund award for \$15,000.00 for the continuance

19		O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated

22		submitted for further prior approval.
