

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the Tohono O'odham Nation Superfund Consolidated Block grant application to USEPA, Region IX, Superfund Division, acceptance of the reserved federal funding and authorization of expenditure in accordance with the attached budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-530

- 1 **WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), Region IX, Superfund**
2 **Division announced there is available cooperative agreement funds in the amount**
3 **of \$80,000.00 to continue the existing Superfund Consolidated Block program; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation prepared a grant application to EPA, Region IX,**
5 **Superfund Division for Cooperative Agreement Funds; and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, the continuation of the existing Superfund Consolidated Block program will allow the**
7 **Nation to develop a contingency plan, a clean up code and a clean up fund for the**
8 **Nation; and**
- 9 **WHEREAS, the Superfund Consolidated Block program will allow the Nation to address**
10 **potentially hazardous waste sites and assist in the Nation's effort to protect and**
11 **maintain the environment for the well being of the Nation's members.**
- 12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
13 **the Tohono O'odham Nation Superfund Consolidated Block Grant application to EPA,**
14 **Region IX, Superfund Division.**
- 15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council accepts the grant funding that EPA has reserved for**
16 **the Tohono O'odham Nation.**
- 17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
18 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official**
19 **are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
20 **amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted**
21 **for further prior approval.**
- 22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and authorizes the**
23 **expenditure of the Superfund Consolidated Block Program Cooperative Agreement**
24 **Funds upon receipt of the award from EPA, Region IX.**

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


