Region IX, Cross Media Division, acceptance of the reserved federal funding and
authorization of expenditure in accordance with the attached budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-531

1 **WHEREAS, the Office of Pesticide Program (OPP) announced there are funds available to**
2 **perform special pesticide projects; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation prepared a small awards grant application to the United**
4 **States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), Region IX, Cross Media Division for**
5 **federal funds in the amount of \$30,500.00; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the federal funds will support sampling the soil and ground water at the four tribal**
7 **farms: Papago, Vaiva Vo, San Lucy and Schuk Toak; and**

8 **WHEREAS, these funds will assist with the Nation's effort to protect and maintain the**
9 **environment for the well being of the Nation's members.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
11 **the Soil & Ground Water small awards grant application to EPA, Region IX, Cross**
12 **Media Division.**

13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
14 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official**
15 **are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
16 **amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted**
17 **for further prior approval.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and authorizes the**
19 **expenditure of the Soil & Ground Water funds upon receipt of the award from EPA,**
20 **Region IX.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH, Day**
22 **of NOVEMBER, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,504.7 FOR; 660.8**
23 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
24 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
25 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
26 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
27 **Stat. 984).**
