

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Acceptance of grant extension #BP-98918901-1 (10/01/98-09/30/01) for  
Brownfields Program and approval of budget modification #1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-532**

1 **WHEREAS, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) awarded \$200,000.00 cooperative**  
2 **agreement funds to the Tohono O'odham Nation for the Brownfields Initiative**  
3 **Redevelopment Project; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Brownfields Redevelopment Project will assess the Minerec Mining Chemical**  
5 **Company, located in San Xavier District and other sites within the Nation with the**  
6 **potential contamination; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the assessment work will be contracted and performed by an environmental**  
8 **consultant; and**

9 **WHEREAS, advertisement within newspapers will be needed to hire a qualified environmental**  
10 **consultant group to assist the Nation in their efforts to protect and maintain the**  
11 **environment for the well being of the Nation's members; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the new negotiated indirect cost for the Nation is 17.4%, the FY 2001 Brownfields**  
13 **budget needs to reflect the new indirect cost rate; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the U.S.E.P.A. has offered an extension until September 30, 2001 for continuance and**  
15 **completion of the Brownfields Economic Redevelopment Initiative Grant Project.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
17 **approves the new line item 700 Advertisement, and the additional amount of \$304.00**  
18 **to reflect a 4% increase on indirect costs for modification of the program's budget.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby also approves**  
20 **and accepts the extension of the Brownfields Economic Redevelopment Initiative**  
21 **Grant until September 30, 2001.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
23 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official,**  
24 **are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**  
25 **amendments affecting funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for**  
26 **further prior approval.**
