- 1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is the governing body of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
- 2 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has always viewed the healthcare and well-being of the**
3 **children of the Nation as a priority of the Nation; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 96-026: "Approving Nation's**
5 **participation in a Five-Year Pathways Full Scale project to prevent Early onset of**
6 **Diabetes in school children funded by the national Heart/Lung and Blood**
7 **Institute;" and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, in partnership with the Gila River Indian Community**
9 **and the University of Arizona, has been an active participant in the "Obesity**
10 **Prevention in American Children" project; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, when asked permission to do so by all interested**
12 **parties, will share Pathway Project results with other Indian communities and**
13 **other university researchers, of which the Nation's data will remain sole**
14 **proprietorship of the Nation; and**
- 15 **WHEREAS, the manuscripts titled:**

2 Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services Research Committee on March
3 27, 2000; and

4 **WHEREAS,** it is the recommendation of Research Committee, Executive Office and the
5 Legislative Oversight committee that the manuscripts provide much information
6 and data from the study and a very positive report in their data and findings.

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves
8 and endorses the submittal of these four (4) manuscripts to scientific journals
9 for consideration of publication.

10 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the data collected shall remain sole proprietorship of the
11 Tohono O'odham Nation.

12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 05TH Day of**
13 **DECEMBER, 2000** at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of **2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
14 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT,** pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
15 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
16 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
17 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
18 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
