

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Establishing December as Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Month)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-567

- 1 **WHEREAS, motor vehicle accidents on the lands of the Tohono O'odham Nation have taken 17**
2 **lives in the past 18 months; and**
- 3 **WHEREAS, each life is precious and each life lost in a motor vehicle accident represents a**
4 **substantial and personal loss to family, friends, community and the Tohono O'odham**
5 **Nation; and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, the economic cost of motor vehicle accidents results in fewer health care dollars**
7 **available for the Nation's people and in incalculable years of potential lives lost; and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, alcohol is a substantial contributing factor in highway deaths; and**
- 9 **WHEREAS, the prevention of drunk and drugged driving is a goal that requires continuous**
10 **vigilance, community support, and education on a daily basis; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, the dedication of December to the memory of all motor vehicle accident victims and**
12 **their families, friends, and community members will set a permanent, annual time**
13 **of remembrance during which to bring together and focus all of our prevention**
14 **efforts; and**
- 15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that December of the year 2000 and each December hereafter,**
16 **is hereby proclaimed as Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Month and**
17 **is dedicated to the memory of all motor vehicle accident victim and their families,**
18 **friends, and community members.**
- 19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all of the branches and employees of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
20 **will work together with government agencies, churches, communities, businesses,**
21 **health providers and schools in order to end driving under the influence.**
- 22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a red ribbon tied to a vehicle antenna shall symbolize**
23 **the commitment to support sober driving over the holidays and throughout the new**
24 **year.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
26 **of DECEMBER 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (c)(8) Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


