

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2001 Addition of Line Items to Tribal Base Budget and Transfer of Funds -
Law Enforcement Tohono O'odham Police Department)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-014

1 **WHEREAS, for fiscal year 2001 the Tohono O'odham Police Department was appropriated funds**
2 **to address various needs of the community and the Police Department's programs;**
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, two additional line items are needed within the Tribal Base Budget, 01-1090, to**
5 **facilitate purchases for ongoing operations; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the first additional line item, 01-1090-727 Building Materials, will be used to purchase**
7 **building materials needed for accessibility ramp systems for the Police Department's**
8 **Modular Building as well as for the creation and maintenance of horse and K-9**
9 **housing units for Departmental Trained Animals; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the second additional line item, 01-1090-753 Trained Animals, will be used to**
11 **purchase an additional K-9 unit for dual purpose, explosives detection; and**

12 **WHEREAS, in order to facilitate such purchases a transfer total of \$10,000.00 from the 01-1090-**
13 **771 account to the 01-1090-727 account in the amount of \$5,000.00 and to the 01-1090-**
14 **753 account in the amount of \$5,000.00 is necessary.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it thereby**
16 **approves the establishment of two additional line items, account number 01-1090-**
17 **727 Building Materials and 01-1090-753 Trained Animals, to the FY 2001 Tohono**
18 **O'odham Police Department Tribal Base Budget.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a total of \$10,000.00 from the 01-1090-771 RM Vehicle account line**
20 **item be transferred to 01-1090-727, Building Materials account line item, for the**
21 **amount of \$5,000.00 and to the 01-1090-753, Trained Animals line item account, for**
22 **the amount of \$5,000.00 to be expended accordingly.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
25 **of JANUARY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,032.1 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; 133.4 NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




