

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Baboquivari District FY 99 Supplement Budget Amendment and Modification)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-026

1 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Council met on January 03, 2001 to review the budget**
2 **modification and amendment, in the amount of Seven thousand eight hundred**
3 **ninety one dollars and sixty one cents (\$7,891.61 from FY'99 Supplement; Budget line**
4 **item 759.32 Other Equipment to create one (1) line item namely:**

5 **810.32 Professional Services in the amount of Seven thousand eight**
6 **hundred ninety one dollars and sixty one cents (\$7,891.61).**

7 **Justification - for direct services provided by a professional person or**
8 **organization delivered under a contract or written agreement.**

9 **WHEREAS, any changes in the justification, additions and/or transfers of funds between budget**
10 **line items are to be reviewed and approved by District Council.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
12 **approve the Baboquivari District Supplemental Budget Modification/Amendment**
13 **transferring the amount of Seven thousand eight hundred ninety one dollars and**
14 **sixty one cents (\$7,891.61) from line item 759.32 - Other Equipment to newly created**
15 **line item 810.32 - Professional Services.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the period for expenditure of the Baboquivari District**
17 **Supplemental funds is hereby extended through December 31, 2001.**

20 **of JANUARY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,865.6 FOR; -0-**

22 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
23 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
24 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
25 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
