(FY 2001 Bureau of Indian Affairs Realty Program Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-034

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the**
2 **Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has approved Resolution No. 2000-284 granting the Executive**
4 **Branch authorization to submit the Annual Funding Agreement and contract**
5 **amendment to the Indian Self Determination Act Master contract, and conduct**
6 **negotiations; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch requires authority to expend for the Realty Program @**
8 **\$67,161.00 + \$11,686.01 (Est. IDC).**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Branch is authorized to expend funds for**
10 **the program listed herein above in the amounts indicated.**

11 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH Day**
12 **of JANUARY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,032.1 FOR; -0-**
13 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 133.4 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
14 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
15 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
16 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
17 **Stat. 984).**
