

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appropriating the sum of \$56,250.00 from Projected Revenues for the purpose
of contracting the services of the National Violence Prevention Resource
Center to Conduct Gang and Juvenile Violence Reduction Initiatives for
the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-036

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is concerned that many youth and families have been**
2 **negatively influenced by youth gangs and youth violence; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is committed to addressing evolving gang and juvenile**
4 **violence issues; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee has reviewed materials describing intervention**
6 **strategies developed by the National Violence Prevention Resource Center and are**
7 **of the opinion that said intervention strategies would be very beneficial for the**
8 **Nation's youth; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recommends contracting with the National**
10 **Violence Prevention Resource Center to continue conducting gang and juvenile**
11 **violence reduction activities; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council finds that the National Violence Prevention**
13 **Resource Center is uniquely qualified to provide these critical services.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:**

- 15 **1. The sum of \$56,250.00 is hereby appropriated from FY 2001 Projected Revenues**
16 **for the purpose of continued contract services of the National Violence**
17 **Prevention Resource Center to conduct gang and juvenile violence initiatives for**
18 **the Nation.**
- 19 **2. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to enter into contract with the National**
20 **Violence Prevention Resource Center to conduct gang and juvenile violence**
21 **initiatives for the Nation.**
- 22 **3. The performance of activities pursuant to the contract described herein shall be**
23 **supervised by the Chairman.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH Day**
25 **of JANUARY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,032.1 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 133.4 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**


