4		including a one-time per capita distribution of \$2,000 to each member of the Nation
5		enrolled on June 28, 1997 (the "Initial Per Capita Distribution"); and
6	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution97-451, the LegislativeCounciladoptedanInitiativeFunding
7		${\bf and Implementation Plan (the ``FIP") which authorized the establish ment of set-aside}$

10	WHEREAS,	by Resolution 97-478, the Legislative Council approved the transfer of funds from the description description
11		Desert Diamond Savings Account to certain designated set-aside accounts
12		established at Bank of America Arizona, including the sum of \$41.5 million to set-
13		aside account no. 3030425-1067524 for the Initial Per Capita Distribution (the "Per
14		Capita Account"); and
15	WHEREAS,	three of the conditions to expenditure of the Per Capita Account specified in the FIP
16		are (1) approval by the Secretary of the Interior of a per capita distribution plan (the
17		"Revenue Allocation Plan") pursuant to the requirements of the Indian Gaming
18		Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C. § 2710 (b) (3); (2) acceptance by the Legislative Council of a
19		Certification of Eligible Members submitted by the Enrollment Of fice and based upon and based upon and based upon are the enrollment of fice are the enrollment of fic
20		receipt of a properly completed and filed Certificate of Eligibility Verification for Per
21		Capita Payment for each member; and (3) as to each Minor Eligible Member,
22		establishment of a restricted account at Bank of America for deposit of such

24	WHEREAS,	$pursuant\ to\ Resolution\ 97\text{-}452, the\ Legislative\ Council\ adopted\ a\ Revenue\ Allocation$
25		Plan and caused the Plan to be submitted for approval by the Phoenix Area Office
26		of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in accordance with authority delegated to the
27		Area Office by the Secretary of the Interior; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts and approves the 21 Certification of Eligible Members, in the form attached hereto. 22 2. The Legislative Council authorizes (a) the transfer of the sum of \$104,000.00 from 23 the Per Capita Account to the special checking account no. 252-350-324 24 established at Bank of America Arizona (the "Per Capita Checking Account"); and 25 (b) upon the joint signature of the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Nation, 26 issuance of a check on the Per Capita Checking Account in the amount of (i) \$2,000 27 to each Eligible Member residing in the United States and listed in the attached 28

6	may be necessary to implement this Resolution.
