

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In support of the Tohono O'odham Education Department FY 2002 Appropriations
Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-085

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is charged with the responsibility of**
2 **supporting programs and or departments and entities that benefit all Tohono**
3 **O'odham; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services and the Employment Assistance Program historically**
5 **have been lacking their own support staff (i.e. a secretary or office support worker);**
6 **and**

7 **WHEREAS, a total of eighty-one (81) students are currently receiving services under the**
8 **programs, fifty-five (55) under Higher Education and twenty-six (26) under**
9 **Employment Assistance Program services, justifying the need of support staff; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the hiring of support staff will allow both program coordinators to focus more on**
11 **recruitment, and retention and completion of Vocational and Academic programs**
12 **of their students; and**

13 **WHEREAS, historically the Employment Assistance program has experienced expending funds**
14 **before the end of the fiscal year thereby causing student applications to be put on**
15 **hold until funding is available; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services is anticipating running out of funds before this current**
17 **fiscal year FY 2002 ends.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council fully supports**
19 **the Tohono O'odham Education Department FY 2002 appropriations budget request**
20 **in the total amount of \$892,154.27, broken down as follows: Higher Education at**
21 **\$541,343.94 and Employment Assistance Program at \$350,810.33.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Appropriations Committee is hereby authorized and directed**
23 **to bring this request to the appropriate agencies, members, and committees of**
24 **Congress.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 28TH Day**
27 **of FEBRUARY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,871.5 FOR; 128.1**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 165.9 [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
30 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
32 **Stat. 984).**
