3	WHEREAS,	American Indians have served in the Armed Force of the United States at a higher per						
4		capita rate than any other minority ethnic; and						
5	WHEREAS,	former Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation, the late Josiah Moore, granted the						
6		Veterans an area to build a Veterans Memorial Park; and						
7	WHEREAS,	there is a need for a Veterans Memorial Monument to honor all who made the						
8		Supreme Sacrifice; and						
9	WHEREAS,	there is a need for a new Veterans Memorial Park where the Veterans Memorial						
10		Monument can be placed; and						
11	WHEREAS,	the United States Air Force has provided several military replicas for the Tohono						
12		O'odham Veterans Memorial Park, F-15 jet plane, M-60 tank, 105 howitzer and						
13		military personnel carrier; and						
14	WHEREAS,	there is a lack of funds to build the Veterans Memorial Monument and Park.						
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby							
16		calls upon Congress and the Administration to set funding for the Veterans Memorial						
17		Monument and Park.

19		to bring this request to the appropriate agencies, members, and committees of						
20		Congress.
