

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2002 Appropriations Priority Listing)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-089

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council establishes priorities annually for
2 consideration by Congress during its Appropriations Hearings; and

3 WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee recommends the establishment of top
4 priorities based on the needs and type of services provided to the people; and


5 WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee has established four areas as the top
6 priorities for FY 2002 for consideration by Congress during the appropriations
7 process.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
9 adopts the following appropriations priority ranking for FY 2002 and respectfully
10 urges Congress to appropriate such funds as necessary to increase the four areas to
11 an exemplary level of funding:

17 by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
18 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
19 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
20 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
