

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Grant (\$10,000) from Southwestern Foundation for Education and
Historical Preservation to the Tohono O'odham Nation for Exhibit Planning
for the Tohono O'odham Nation's Cultural Center and Museum)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-100

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of cultural history as part of
2 an educational priority; and

3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 2000-275 on
4 June 09, 2000 approving appropriations for the design, construction, staffing and
5 operations of a Cultural Center Museum for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

6 WHEREAS, the Cultural Affairs Office submitted a grant application to the Southwestern
7 Foundation for Education and Historical Preservation to fund preliminary exhibit
8 planning for the Cultural Center Museum as part of the design phase; and

9 WHEREAS, the Cultural Affairs Office received notification of a grant award of \$10,000 from the
10 Southwestern Foundation for Education and Historical Preservation in December
11 2000.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
13 request of the Cultural Affairs Office to accept this \$10,000 grant from the
14 Southwestern Foundation for Education and Historical Preservation for exhibit
15 planning and to set up an account from which expenditures can be made.

16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH Day
17 of MARCH, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,728.75 FOR; -0-
18 AGAINST; 436.75 NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
19 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
20 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
21 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
22 Stat. 984).
