5		operations of a Cultural Center Museum for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Cultural Affairs Office submitted a grant application to the Southwestern
7		Foundation for Education and Historical Preservation to fund preliminary exhibit
8		planning for the Cultural Center Museum as part of the design phase; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Cultural Affairs Office received notification of a grant award of \$10,000 from the
10		Southwestern Foundation for Education and Historical Preservation in December
11		2000.
12	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
13		request of the Cultural Affairs Office to accept this \$10,000 grant from the
14		Southwestern Foundation for Education and Historical Preservation for exhibit
15		planning and to set up an account from which expenditures can be made.
