

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(In Support of Higher Education Services FY-2001, Budget Mod. #1 Acct. 10-1215)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-106**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through the Higher Education Services program has**  
2 **been successfully providing counseling and financial assistance to eligible Tohono**  
3 **O'odham to attend Post-Secondary Institutes; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services has savings from Fiscal Years 1997, 1998, 1999 in the**  
5 **amount of \$1,078,222.18, which was identified by the Grants & Contracts Office.**

6 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the**  
7 **Higher Education Services budget modification #1 reflecting savings from FY-97, 98,**  
8 **99, in the amount of \$1,078,222.18 with a total modification in the amount of**  
9 **\$1,795,424.90.**

10 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
11 **of MARCH, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,037.4 FOR; -0-**  
12 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 128.1 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
13 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
14 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
15 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
16 **Stat. 984).**
