12	WHEREAS,	the supplemental request is to allow for the expansion of the department by hiring
13		additional staff, provide funding to cover cost of investigations, training, purchase
14		equipment, moving expenses and for the disconnection and reconnecting of office
15		equipment and services; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Office has submitted a Supplemental Request to be funded from the
17		Nation's general fund for fiscal year 2001; and
18	WHEREAS,	$the \ Executive, Commerce, Budget \ and \ Finance \ Committees \ recommend \ approval \ of \$
19		the Gaming Office Supplemental Budget request by the Legislative Council.
20	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does approve
21		the Gaming Office Supplemental budget in the amount of \$786,965.73 for fiscal year
