

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Tohono O'odham Gaming Office Supplemental Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-107

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 00-457, the fiscal year 2001 budget of the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Gaming Office was approved by the Legislative Council as part of the Executive**
3 **Branch budget for such fiscal year; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the authority of the Gaming Office is to regulate gaming conducted on the Nation's**
5 **land to establish and maintain gaming integrity for the benefit of the Nation, Gaming**
6 **Employees and the general public; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Gaming Office has the overall civil regulatory authority over gaming activities as**
8 **provided in the Gaming Ordinance; and**

9 **WHEREAS, during fiscal year 2000 the Nation approved a business loan agreement to finance the**
10 **construction, development and equipment of the third Gaming Facility located at I-19**
11 **and Pima Mine Road; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the supplemental request is to allow for the expansion of the department by hiring**
13 **additional staff, provide funding to cover cost of investigations, training, purchase**
14 **equipment, moving expenses and for the disconnection and reconnecting of office**
15 **equipment and services; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Gaming Office has submitted a Supplemental Request to be funded from the**
17 **Nation's general fund for fiscal year 2001; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Executive, Commerce, Budget and Finance Committees recommend approval of**
19 **the Gaming Office Supplemental Budget request by the Legislative Council.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does approve**
21 **the Gaming Office Supplemental budget in the amount of \$786,965.73 for fiscal year**
22 **2001, in the form attached hereto and that such budget shall be funded from the**
23 **Fiscal Year 2001 General Fund Budget Reserve.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the personnel and operational cost shall be made a part of the**
25 **Gaming Office base budget.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
27 **of MARCH, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**
30 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
