9		approved for \$32,589.00, from the Fiscal Year 2000, Special Department of				
10		Transportation Allocation of Highway Trust Funds, for the purpose of developing a				
11		Tribal Transportation Improvements Plan (T.T.I.P.); and				
12	WHEREAS,	Modification Number 75, to Fiscal Year 1997, Contract No. CTH54T61071 was effective				
13		on September 29, 2000, which added the T.T.I.P. and I.R.R. Inventory to the master				
14		contract with BIA; and				
15	WHEREAS,	the Planning Department Transportation Planning Program has been working in the				
16		Districts on developing street naming plans under a previously approved Intermodal				
17		Surface Transportation Equity Act (ISTEA) 2% Transportation Planning Grant; and				
18	WHEREAS,	the Planning Department's Transportation Planning Program has been directed to				
19		pursue improvements in transportation planning, policy, maintenance and				
20		construction.
