

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY-2001 Budgets for the Indian Reservation Roads (IRR) Inventory)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-113

1 **WHEREAS, on June 19, 2000 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council enacted Resolution No.**
2 **2000-284, "Authorizing Submission and Negotiation of the Fiscal Year 2001 Annual**
3 **Funding Agreement to the Indian Self-Determination Act Master Contract with the**
4 **Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2000-284, states that it is the desire of the Nation, "... to continue**
6 **operation of such programs, functions, services and activities presently performed**
7 **by the Bureau including Transportation Planning..."; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Nation has been offered and accepted first right of refusal on the PL 93-638**
9 **contract to conduct the Indian Reservation Inventory Data Collection, Project**
10 **H544891, as per the Western Regional Office Road Inventory Update-Data Collection**
11 **Scope of Work and Work Plan, dated March 01, 2000, in the amount of \$66,446.00; and**

12 **WHEREAS, Modification Number 75, to Fiscal Year 1997, Contract No. CTH54T61071 was effective**
13 **on September 29, 2000, which added the T.T.I.P. and I.R.R. Inventory to the master**
14 **contract with BIA; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Planning Department Transportation Planning Program has been working in the**
16 **Districts on developing street naming plans under a previously approved Intermodal**
17 **Surface Transportation Equity Act (ISTEA) 2% Transportation Planning Grant; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Planning Department's Transportation Planning Program has been directed to**
19 **pursue improvements in transportation planning, policy, maintenance and**
20 **construction.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the attached budget to conduct I.R.R. Inventory**
22 **project within the Planning Department Transportation Planning Program is**
23 **hereby approved by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day**
25 **of MARCH, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,037.4 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 128.1 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






