5		Indian Patients to other health care resources such as Medicare/Medicaid; and					
6	WHEREAS,	the Indian Health Care Improvement Act provides comprehensive directives to the					
7		Federal Government with regard to Indian Health; and along with the Snyder Act of					
8		1921, provides overall guidance and authority for the programs of the U.S. Indian					
9		Health Services; and					
10	WHEREAS,	the Indian Health Care Improvement Act is scheduled to expire at the end of fiscal					
11		year 2000; and					
12	WHEREAS,	National Indian Organizations and Tribes participated and consulted with the Indian					
13		Health Service and Federal Government to advise on the Re-Authorization and					
14		proposed language changes to the Indian Health Care Improvement Act; and					
15	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has participated at the tribal, state, regional and federal					
16		level in support of the Re-Authorization.					
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:						
18		1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is requesting Congressional support for					
19		the re-authorization of Indian Health Care Improvement Act, P.L. 94-437 with its					
20		proposed changes.					
21		2. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and directs the					
22		Appropriations Committee to lobby agencies, members and Committees of					
23		Congress for the re-authorization of the Indian Health Care Improvement Act, P.L.					
24		94–437 with its proposed changes.
