

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(BIA/Tribal Budget System Priority Ranking for 2003)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-126

1 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Papago Agency presented to the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Legislative Council the projected FY 2003 Planning Base Amounts under the Tribal**
3 **Priority Allocations of the Bureau Budget for FY 2003; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Papago Agency submitted the Tribal Priority Allocation programs and funding**
5 **allocation levels for contract programs and the unmet need and narrative**
6 **justification statements forms to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the priority ranking provide the Tohono O'odham Nation the opportunity to**
8 **participate in the Federal Budget Formulation process for the allocation and ranking**
9 **resources available under the Tribal Priority Allocations budget category; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the ranking depicts the Nation's priorities as previously established; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the proposed FY 2003**
12 **justifications for P.L. 93-638 contracted programs Priority Ranking Numbers as**
13 **submitted by the Executive Office; and justifications for Agency operated programs**
14 **and Priority Ranking Numbers as submitted by Papago Agency.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**
16 **Projected Planning Base Amounts and Ranking under the Bureau budget be adopted**
17 **for FY 2003.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the following Top Ten**
19 **(10) Priority Ranking be adopted for FY 2003 for the P.L. 93-638 contracted programs:**

- 20 **1. Human Services (Services to Children, Elderly, Families; ICWA)**
- 21 **2. Community Development - No Yr. (Road Maintenance)**
- 22 **3. Human Services - No Yr. (Housing Improvement Program)**
- 23 **4. Education (Scholarship; Adult Education; Johnson O'Malley)**
- 24 **5. Tribal Government (Tribal Courts)**
- 25 **6. Resources Management (Agriculture Extension; Water Resources;**
26 **Range Conservation and Management Program)**
- 27 **7. Trust Services (Real Estate Services)**
- 28 **8. Community Development (Economic Development)**
- 29 **9. Public Safety & Justice (Law Enforcement - Ranger Program)**
- 30 **10. General Administration**

2 of MARCH, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,079.6 FOR; -0-
3 AGAINST; 85.9 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
4 Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
5 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
6 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
7 Stat. 984).

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


