## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Accepting Certification of Eligible Members and Authorizing the Initial Expenditure of Funds for Per Capita Payments under the Initiative)

1	WHEREAS,	on June 28, 1997 the voters of the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") approved
2		Initiative No. IN-01-97 (the "Initiative"); and
3	WHEREAS,	the Initiative authorized funding from Gaming Revenues for several measures,
4		including a one-time per capita distribution of \$2,000 to each member of the Nation
5		enrolled on June 28, 1997 (the "Initial Per Capita Distribution"); and
6	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution97-451, the LegislativeCounciladoptedanInitiativeFunding
7		and Implementation Plan (the  ``FIP") which authorized the establish ment of set-aside
8		${\bf accounts}  {\bf for the  Initial  Per  Capita  Distribution  and  other  Initiative  measures, and  set  {\bf other  Initiative  measures,  and  a$
9		certain conditions on the expenditure of funds from such accounts; and
10	WHEREAS,	by  Resolution  97-478, the  Legislative  Council  approved  the  transfer  of  funds  from  the  description  description
11		Desert Diamond Savings Account to certain designated set-aside accounts
12		established at Bank of America Arizona, including the sum of \$41.5 million to set-
13		aside account no. 3030425-1067524 for the Initial Per Capita Distribution (the "Per
14		Capita Account"); and
15	WHEREAS,	three of the conditions to expenditure of the Per Capita Account specified in the FIP
16		are (1) approval by the Secretary of the Interior of a per capita distribution plan (the
17		"Revenue Allocation Plan") pursuant to the requirements of the Indian Gaming
18		Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C. § 2710 (b) (3); (2) acceptance by the Legislative Council of a

25		Plan and caused the Plan to be submitted for approval by the Phoenix Area Office
26		of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in accordance with authority delegated to the
27		Area Office by the Secretary of the Interior; and

RESOLUTION NO. 01-136 (Accepting Certification of Eligible Members and Authorizing the Initial Expenditure of Funds for Per Capita Payments under the Initiative) Page 2 of 4 WHEREAS, by letter dated December 18, 1997, the Area Office approved the Revenue Allocation 1 2 Plan with respect to the Initial Per Capita Distribution and disapproved the Plan with 3 respect to the Biennial Per Capita Payments; and 4 WHEREAS, an agreement with Bank of America has not yet been finalized for the establishment 5 of the restricted accounts which is required as a condition to disbursement of the 6 Initial Per Capita Distribution to such accounts for Minor Eligible Members; and 7 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 97-525, 98-010, 98-037, 98-084, 98-128, 98-192, 98-207, 98-8 278, 98-316, 98-360, 98-431, 98-478, 98-505, 99-006, 99-041, 99-081, 99-142, 99-201, 99-9 312, 99-363, 99-422, 99-478, 99-563, 99-635, 2000-005, 2000-037, 2000-085, 2000-148, 10 2000-177, 2000-225, 2000-299, 2000-356, 2000-399, 2000-488, 2000-527, 2000-555, 01-005, and 01-051 the Legislative Council accepted and approved Certifications of 11 12 Eligible Members for the Initial Per Capita Distribution, and disbursements have 13 been made to such members; and 14 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Office has filed with the Legislative Council a Certification of Eligible 15 Members listing 36 adult members who are eligible for receipt of the Initial Per Capita Distribution; and 16 17 WHEREAS. all conditions under the laws of the United States and the Nation have been satisfied 18 to permit the disbursement of the Initial Per Capita Distribution to the members 19 listed in the Certification of Eligible members. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: 20 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts and approves the 21 Certification of Eligible Members, in the form attached hereto. 22 2. The Legislative Council authorizes (a) the transfer of the sum of \$72,000.00 from 23 the Per Capita Account to the special checking account no. 252-350-324 24 established at Bank of America Arizona (the "Per Capita Checking Account"); and 25 (b) upon the joint signature of the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Nation, 26 issuance of a check on the Per Capita Checking Account in the amount of (i) \$2,000 27 to each Eligible Member residing in the United States and listed in the attached 28
