

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 2002 Elderly Title VI Program Continuation Request)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-150

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the elderly**
2 **members of the Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has been made possible in part by**
4 **Article VI of the Older American's Act of 1978, as amended; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Elderly Program desires to seek continued funding by submitting a continuation**
6 **request to the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration on Aging**
7 **for FY 2002 in the amount of \$100,960.00; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Elderly Program will benefit elder members of the Tohono O'odham Nation by**
9 **providing for their nutritional and social support services.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
11 **approves:**

12 **1. The continuation request for continued funding of the Elderly Title VI Program**
13 **to provide services to eligible members of the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

14 **2. That the term of this budget shall commence on April 01, 2001 and end March 31,**
15 **2002.**

16 **3. The Tohono O'odham Nation officials, to wit: The Chairman and Vice-Chairman**
17 **or designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,**
18 **and expend such funds per attached budget, provided however, that any**
19 **amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this grant shall be**
20 **submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03rd Day**
22 **of APRIL, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165,5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
23 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
24 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
25 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
26 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


