13		to provide services to eligible members of the Tohono O'odham Nation.
14		2. That the term of this budget shall commence on April 01, 2001 and end March 31,
15		2002.

17		or designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
18		and expend such funds per attached budget, provided however, that any
19		amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this grant shall be
20		submitted for further prior approval by this Council.
