

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Coldfields Community FY'01 Supplement Budget Amendment and Modification)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-154

1 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Council met on December 16, 2000, to review Coldfields**  
2 **Community budget modification and amendment. In the amount of two thousand**  
3 **five hundred thirty-six dollars and five cents (\$2,536.05) from FY'99 Supplement**  
4 **Budget line item 31-7014-727.32 Materials to create (3) line items namely:**

5 **711.32 Communications in the amount of Two Hundred Three Dollars and Ninety**  
6 **One Cents (\$203.91). Justification - To pay for telephone used for**  
7 **community business or emergency calls.**

8 **712.32 Gas, Oil & Coolant in the amount of One Thousand Three Hundred**  
9 **Seventeen Dollars and Thirty Three Cents (\$1,317.33). Justification - For**  
10 **purchase of fluids for vehicle, gas, oil, coolant, brake fluid, transmission**  
11 **fluids and window cleaner.**

12 **771.32 Repair Maintenance Vehicle in the amount of One Thousand Fourteen**  
13 **Dollars and Eighty One Cents (\$1,014.81). Justification - Service and**  
14 **maintenance agreement for community vehicles extended warranties,**  
15 **windshield replacements labor and parts.**

16 **WHEREAS, any changes in the justification, additions and/or transfer of funds between budget**  
17 **line items are to be reviewed and approved by the District Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
19 **the Baboquivari District Supplement Budget Modification/Amendment new line**  
20 **items 711.32 Communications, 712.32 Gas, Oil & Coolant and 771.32 Repair**  
21 **Maintenance Vehicle.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budget modification in the amount of Two Thousand Five**  
23 **Hundred Thirty Six Dollars and Five cents (\$2,536.05) be distributed to the new line**  
24 **items aforementioned.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
26 **of APRIL, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
27 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**
