RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Allocating Public Law 99-503 Funds to San Lucy District in order for the District to complete Phase III Housing Rehabilitation Project)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-159

1	WHEREAS,	in 1986, the United States Congress enacted the Gila Bend Indian Reservation Lands
2		Replacement Act, Public Law 99-503 ("Replacement Act"), to provide funds to the
3		Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") to be used expressly and solely for the benefit of
4		San Lucy District for "land and water rights acquisition, economic and community
5		development, and relocation costs"; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Land Use Planning Committee determined that the housing in San Lucy District
7		was in need of rehabilitation and repair and developed a three (3) phase approach to
8		address the inferior housing in the District; and
9	WHEREAS,	San Lucy District has presented the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council with
10		Resolution No. SL-03-42-01 wherein San Lucy District requests allocation of Two
11		Million Three Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Five Hundred Twenty One Dollars
12		(\$2,349,521) to complete "San Lucy District Phase III Rehabilitation Project," San Lucy
13		District established a Land Use Planning Committee to analyze the housing needs of
14		the District; and
15	WHEREAS,	San Lucy District has contracted with Vi-ikam Doag Industries, Inc. ["VDI"], a tribally
16		chartered entity, which is the economic development arm of San Lucy District and
17		whose operations include a Construction Division along with personnel trained and
18		experienced in the construction industry; and
19	WHEREAS,	Phases I and II of the rehabilitation and repair plan have been completed; and
20	WHEREAS,	for Phase III, all the homes in San Lucy District have been assessed and the owners
21		consulted as to their needs and desires, such as additions of extra rooms, porches,
22		patios, utility rooms, modifications to bathrooms as needed to accommodate the
23		elderly and disabled; and
24	WHEREAS,	VDI has assessed the individual homes in the District and has begun the
25		repair/remodeling to the homes in San Lucy District; and
26	WHEREAS,	VDI is in communication with the Ki:Ki Association, the Nation's Housing Authority,
27		and is keeping Ki:Ki Association apprised of its activities and is coordinating the

1		repairs/remodeling in such a way that federal funds will be used whenever possible					
2		to fund certain repairs; and					
3	WHEREAS,	VDI and the San Lucy District Council have determined that Phase III will cost a total					
4		of \$2,349,521, exclusive of any federal funds available through the Ki:Ki Association,					
5		to complete as set forth in estimate attached to Resolution No. SL-03-42-01 titled "San					
6		Lucy District Phase III Rehabilitation Project"; and					
7	WHEREAS,	the San Lucy District III Rehabilitation Project constitutes community development					
8		and, through VDI, provides economic development opportunities for San Lucy					
9		District members, and therefore is consistent with the goals set forth in the					
10		Replacement Act, Public Law 99-503.					
11	NOW, THEF	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby					
12		appropriates Two Million Three Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Five Hundred Twenty					
13		One Dollars (\$2,349,521) from San Lucy Public Law 99-503 funds and releases such					
14	sum to San Lucy District to allow San Lucy District to proceed with the rehabilitation						
15		of the homes in the San Lucy District in accordance with the San Lucy District Phase					
16		III Rehabilitation Project.
