5		boundary of the Nation; and						
6	WHEREAS,	part of the scope of work of that Agreement is the installation of load-cell scour						
7		sensors and pressure sensors in the bed of Vamori Wash to provide information						
8		about water flows and bed scour in Vamori Wash; and						
9	WHEREAS,	this work has not been completed in the allotted time due to untimely rainfall and						
10		scheduling conflicts with other USGS work; and						
11	WHEREAS,	it is to the benefit of the Nation to extend the time period for performance of the						
12		Agreement for an additional three months until June 30, 2001; and						
13	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed and approved						
14		of the proposed Amendment No. 2 which extends the term of the Agreement until June						
15		30, 2001.						
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves							
17		Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement substantially in the form attached hereto, and						
18		authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to execute the Amendment.
