

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of The Vision Workbook... Tohono O'odham Youth Preventing the Cycle of Diabetes
and administer workbook to students attending the Tohono O'odham High School)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-164

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham recognized the health of members as one of its highest**
2 **priorities; and**

3 **WHEREAS, on March 3, 1997, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 97-**
4 **080, which approved the establishment of a partnership between Washington**
5 **University in St. Louis, Missouri, to establish a "Community Participation to Develop**
6 **a Nutrition Activation Program for the Prevention of Diabetes Among the Tohono**
7 **O'odham;" and**

8 **WHEREAS, Washington University has completed preliminary work on this program and has**
9 **designed a program which targets diabetes prevention among high school youth; and**

10 **WHEREAS, Washington University has developed a student workbook titled, "The Vision**
11 **Workbook... Tohono O'odham Youth Preventing the Cycle of Diabetes;" and**

12 **WHEREAS, the BIA School Board has approved the administration of the workbook to students**
13 **attending Tohono O'odham High School; and**

14 **WHEREAS, Washington University requests approval from the Tohono O'odham Nation to**
15 **administer the workbook to students attending Tohono O'odham High School.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the "Community Participation to Develop a Nutrition**
17 **Activation Program for the Prevention of Diabetes Among the Tohono O'odham" now**
18 **includes the development and evaluation of a student workbook titled, The Vision**
19 **Workbook... Tohono O'odham Youth Preventing the Cycle of Diabetes.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the student workbook titled, The Vision Workbook...**
21 **Tohono O'odham Youth Preventing the Cycle of Diabetes has been reviewed and**
22 **approved by the Legislative Council and may be administered to students attending**
23 **the Tohono O'odham High School**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH. Day**
25 **of APRIL, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
26 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2)**
27 **& (l) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**


