

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Extension of Fiscal Year 2001 Department of Justice Emergency Border
Funding Project Into Fiscal Year 2002 - Law Enforcement)

RESOLUTION NO. 01-195

1 WHEREAS, in fiscal year 2001 the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department was awarded
2 Emergency Border Funding Project through the Department of Justice in the amount
3 of \$144,000.00; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council in fiscal year 2001 passed resolution 01-016
5 to accept and expend these grant funds; and

6 WHEREAS, due to the time consuming nature of adhering to the Nation's purchasing policies and
7 procedures for the procurement of items, the time initially allotted is insufficient to
8 complete all projects on or before September 30, 2001 as originally budgeted; and

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department is requesting to extend the original
10 budget to March 01, 2002 to reflect the grant award period.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the attached budget, in the amount of \$144,000.00 for
12 the Department of Justice Emergency Border Funding Project, is hereby extended to
13 March 01, 2002.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award period for the Department of Justice Emergency Border
15 Funding Project expires on March 01, 2002.


16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day
17 of MAY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,792.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
18 372.7 VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of
19 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
20 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
21 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
