7	Project grant for the amount of \$2,000.00 and authorizes the use of this grant and
8	authorizes the Venito Garcia Library and Archives to spend the funds provided.

14	(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
