

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 2001 Bureau of Indian Affairs Realty Office Budget Amendment #1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-203**

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council through Resolution No. 01-034 approved authorization for the**  
2 **Executive Branch to expend funds in the amount of \$79,029.01, @ \$67,161.00 +**  
3 **\$11,686.01 (Est. IDC) for the Realty Office; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the actual amount awarded for FY 2001 was \$43,709.00 for FY 2001 and \$17,875.00 of**  
5 **savings from FY 2000 amounting to \$61,584.00 with \$10,715.61 (Est. IDC) this amount**  
6 **is \$6,547.40 less than what was initially authorized; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch requests the Legislative Council to amend the budget approved**  
8 **by Resolution No. 01-034 and reauthorize with this resolution to expend funds with**  
9 **adjustment to reflect the actual funding of \$72,299.61; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Realty Office in this adjustment is modifying its budget moving savings from the**  
11 **Salary and Fringe Benefit Line Items in the amount of \$17,543.00 to the Operational**  
12 **Budget and including additional new line items, 711 communications budgeted in**  
13 **the amount of \$3,043.00 and 894 non-major equipment budgeted in the amount of**  
14 **\$1,000.00, \$6,952.60 is dispersed to existing line items.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council amends Resolution No. 01-034 and**  
16 **approves the adjustment of the authorized budget of the Realty Office to reflect the**  
17 **actual figure funded and the modification and additional new line items for the**  
18 **Realty Office.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Branch is authorized to expend funds for the Office**  
20 **listed herein above in the amounts indicated.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08<sup>TH</sup>, Day**  
22 **of MAY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
23 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**  
24 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
25 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
26 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
