

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Re-Authorization of the Judiciary Branch FY99 and Appropriation Funds for FY 2001;
Authorization of Expenditures)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-204

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved Judiciary plans for constructing**
2 **Girls' and Boys' Homes to provide minimum security homes for children adjudicated**
3 **to be "child offenders"; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary has completed much of the construction at the homes, however,**
5 **circumstances which are not the fault of the Judiciary have prevented timely completion**
6 **of the group home projects; and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary is therefore unable to complete construction of certain, office space, and a**
8 **sewer and water system by September 30, 2000; and**
- 9 **WHEREAS, building renovations are needed for certain Judiciary programs housed in two mobile**
10 **buildings; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY01 Judicial Branch budget by**
12 **Resolution No. 2000-355, thereby authorizing the appropriated funds for expenditure by**
13 **the Judiciary; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, the funds approved by the Legislative Council for FY 01 do not include funds to complete**
15 **the Phase II of the Group Home Project nor do they include any other significant funds for**
16 **alterations within the current Judicial facilities; and**
- 17 **WHEREAS, construction funds have been identified in the FY 99 Re-Authorization in the amount of**
18 **four hundred and eight thousand, four hundred and forty-three dollars (\$408,443.00) and**
19 **also in the FY 2000 Appropriated funds in the amount of thirty-two thousand, two hundred**
20 **dollars (\$32,200.00) which would, if not used, revert to the Nation's general fund**
21 **September 30, 2000; and**
- 22 **WHEREAS, the funds identified totaling four hundred and forty thousand, six hundred forty-three**
23 **dollars (\$440,643.00) should be made available for the purposes of completing the Judicial**
24 **projects identified above.**
- 25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the attached**
26 **budget entitled Tohono O'odham Judiciary FY 2001 Re-Authorization Funds, is hereby**
27 **approved as submitted and is authorized to be expended accordingly.**
- 28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the balances and amounts identified by the attached budget,**
29 **totaling four hundred and forty thousand, six hundred forty-three dollars**
30 **(\$440,643.00) are hereby re-authorized for expenditure in the fiscal year 2001.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day of MAY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,877.4 FOR; 160.0 AGAINST; 128.1 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


