

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2002-Title VI Cash in Lieu of Commodities Funds April 01, 2001 - March 31, 2002)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-225

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the Elders of the**
2 **Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Senior Services Program has been made possible in**
4 **part by Title VI of the Older American's Act of 1978 as amended; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the services provided to the elders has been beneficial and services continue to be**
6 **necessary to provide nutrition and socialization support; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Senior Services Program has prepared a budget to utilize Title VI Cash in Lieu of**
8 **Commodities funds to continue to provide nutrition and socialization support**
9 **services to eligible elders.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 11 **1. That it hereby approves the budget for the Cash in Lieu of Commodities funds for**
12 **Title VI funding for the Senior Services Program to maintain services it has**
13 **proposed per attachments in light of the requirements and regulations.**
- 14 **2. The Tohono O'odham Nation officials, to wit: The Chairman is hereby authorized**
15 **to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments**
16 **affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for**
17 **further prior approval by this Council.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH. Day**
19 **of MAY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
20 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
21 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
22 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
23 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
