

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adoption of the Human Resources Development Committee Plan of Operation)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 01-229

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to establish rules**
2 **and procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing**
3 **committees, boards and special committees pursuant to the Constitution of the**
4 **Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a) and (b); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is empowered to prescribe the duties and**
6 **powers of all Legislative Committees; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee has reviewed and discussed the purposes, powers and duties of**
8 **the Human Resource and Development Committee; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee recommends the adoption of the Human Resource and**
10 **Development Committee Plan of Operation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the attached Plan of Operation**
12 **and has incorporated the necessary changes.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
14 **adopts the attached Plan of Operation for the Human Resource and Development**
15 **Committee under the Legislative Branch.**

16 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH. Day of**
17 **MAY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,704.4 FOR; 289.3 AGAINST;**
18 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 171.8 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
19 **1 (a) and (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
20 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
21 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
22 **Stat. 984).**
