1	WHEREAS,	Tohono O'odham member Gina Celaya was convicted of first degree murder and
2		armed robbery following an incident that occurred in December, 1992 when Ms.
3		Celaya was fourteen years and two days old; and
4	WHEREAS,	Ms. Celaya is the youngest person ever tried and convicted as an adult for murder in
5		Pima County; and
6	WHEREAS,	Ms. Celaya received a sentence of 35-years-to-life which she is now serving; and
7	WHEREAS,	Ms. Celaya's state court appeal and post-conviction proceedings have been exhausted
8		and the state courts have refused to grant Ms. Celaya a new trial; and
9	WHEREAS,	the lawyers who represented Ms. Celaya at the state level have contacted the Nation
10		and requested that funds be appropriated to retain counsel to file a federal Petition
11		for Writ of Habeas Corpus on Ms. Celaya's behalf because they believe that her
12		federal constitutional rights were violated; and
13	WHEREAS,	Mary Celaya, Ms. Celaya's mother, has contacted the Nation and requested on Ms.
14		Celaya's behalf, that funds be appropriated for this purpose; and
15	WHEREAS,	the  request  to  appropriate  funds  for  this  purpose  has  been  reviewed  by  the  Domestic
16		Affairs Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee and forwarded to the full
17		Council for consideration; and
18	WHEREAS,	funds are available for appropriation in the Budget Reserve.
19	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
20		appropriates \$50,000 from the unobligated Budget Reserve to the Law Offices of
21		Walter Nash, III, P.C. to represent Gina Celaya in her petition for writ of habeas
22		$corpus \ to \ the \ United \ States \ District \ Court for \ the \ District \ of Arizona \ and \ any \ necessary$
23		appeal to the United States Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals.
24	BE IT FURT	HER RESOLVED that the Nation's Treasurer is by hereby authorized to transfer
25		\$50,000 to the Law Offices of Walter Nash, III, P.C. as a refundable retainer on behalf
26		of Gina Celaya for her petition for writ of habeas corpus to the United States District
