

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving a Second Supplemental Set-A-Side Appropriation of \$5.5 Million**  
**from the Tohono O'odham Nation Gaming Revenue Savings to be**  
**Distributed Equally Among the Eleven Districts of the Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-235

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Tohono O'odham Council Res. No. 94-098, "*Authorizing Gaming Revenue***  
2 ***Distribution Formula*"; an allocation of gaming revenue funds was provided to each**  
3 **of the Eleven (11) Districts of the Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, in November of 1998 the districts approached the Tohono O'odham Council to**  
5 **request a supplemental set-a-side appropriation of \$5.5 million from the Tohono**  
6 **O'odham Nation Gaming Revenue Savings; and**

7 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Tohono O'odham Council Res. No. 98-486, "*Approving a Supplemental***  
8 ***Set-A-Side Appropriation of \$5.5 Million from the Tohono O'odham Nation Gaming***  
9 ***Revenue Savings to be Distributed Equally Among the Eleven Districts of the Nation,*"**  
10 **the Eleven Districts of the Nation received the requested supplemental funding; and**

11 **WHEREAS, all the Districts of the Nation utilized the November 1998 appropriation for the**  
12 **benefit of their constituents, however, there are still unmet needs in their respective**  
13 **districts; and**

14 **WHEREAS, all the Districts of the Nation realize that the Gaming Revenue Allocation made each**  
15 **August is insufficient to meet their constituents' needs each fiscal year; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Districts of the Nation believe that second set-a-side appropriation from the**  
17 **gaming revenue savings of \$5.5 million to be distributed equally among the eleven**  
18 **districts of the Nation, would assist in meeting the unmet needs of their constituents;**  
19 **and**

20 **WHEREAS, a majority of the councils of the Eleven Districts of the Nation have enacted**  
21 **resolutions supporting this second appropriation.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
23 **supports and approves a second supplemental set-a-side appropriation of \$5.5**  
24 **million from the savings portion of the Tohono O'odham Nation Gaming Revenues to**  
25 **all eleven (11) districts of the Nation to address the district priorities.**

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$5.5 million will be divided equally to the eleven (11) districts**  
27 **of the Nation in the amount of \$500,000 per district, and that the funds will be**

1                   disbursed upon presentation and adoption of district budgets to the Tohono  
2                   O'odham Council.

3   The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day  
4   of MAY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,005.5 FOR; 160.0  
5   AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section  
6   1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
7   O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
8   Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
9   Stat. 984).
