**Productions, Lighting Sound)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-241**

1 **WHEREAS, this matter has come to the attention of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for**  
2 **resolution that a Business Plan was submitted and denied and an appeal was made**  
3 **to the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, Mr. Kenneth A. Enos, enrolled member of the Tohono O'odham Nation did approach**  
5 **the Legislative Council for further direction and resolution; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Mr. Enos did follow the proper protocol for resolution to such a matter as known to**  
7 **the best of his knowledge; and**

8 **WHEREAS, Mr. Enos did submit a Business Plan and the necessary documentation required to**  
9 **obtain a Business Grant, pursuant to the Initiative 97-01, the O'odham Voice on Use**  
10 **of Gaming Revenues, and the Plan of Operations for the Business Grant Program; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Economic Development Task Force did receive and review Mr. Enos' Business**  
12 **Plan; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Task Force did not approve of Mr. Enos' Business Plan and the Plan was reviewed**  
14 **twice; and**

15 **WHEREAS, a letter Appealing the Task Force's denial was submitted to the Chairman of the**  
16 **Tohono O'odham Nation and a response was submitted and recommendation was in**  
17 **support of Mr. Enos' Business Plan; and**

18 **WHEREAS, information and presentation was presented to the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
19 **Council for support, direction and a decision as to Mr. Kenneth A. Enos' Business**  
20 **Plan.**

21 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby supports**  
22 **that Mr. Kenneth A. Enos' Business Plan be supported by the Economic Development**  
23 **Board.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH. Day**  
25 **of MAY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,753.15 FOR; 307.55**  
26 **AGAINST; 104.8 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
27 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
30 **Stat. 984).**

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
