

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the Memorandum of Agreement with the University of Utah regarding the**  
**Geographic Information System (GIS) Project)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-243**

1 **WHEREAS, an accurate comprehensive Geographic Information System (GIS) will assist the**  
2 **Tohono O'odham Nation in its efforts at preservation and protection of its**  
3 **environment and natural resources, and provide a tool to be used in land use**  
4 **planning decisions; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the DIGIT Lab, an affiliate of the University of Utah's Department of Geography ("the**  
6 **DIGIT Lab") has the personnel, resources and skills to assist the Nation in creating**  
7 **such a GIS system; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation and the University of Utah have entered into discussions**  
9 **about a joint project that would be funded through the Southwest Center for**  
10 **Research and Policy (SCERP) Tribal Environmental Program (STEP); and**

11 **WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Agreement has been drafted that outlines the scope of work,**  
12 **requirements, and conditions of this project; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement has been reviewed by the Natural Resources**  
14 **Committee and is recommended for approval.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
16 **approves the attached Memorandum of Agreement with the University of Utah and**  
17 **authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to sign it on behalf of the Nation.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby encourages all of the Nation's**  
19 **Departments, as well as other agencies that may have relevant data, to cooperate in**  
20 **this project.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all products, data, and materials collected from the Nation for**  
22 **this project shall remain the property of the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
25 **of MAY, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,037.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
26 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 128.1 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**  
27 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
30 **Stat. 984).**


