

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorization to expend 638 Savings for the FY 2001 Bureau of Indian Affairs Fund
Account 10-5015, Water Resources Study Program Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-250

1 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program of the Natural Resources Department has**
2 **accumulated savings in fiscal years 1997 through 2000 in its Bureau of Indian Affairs**
3 **funding provided by the Nation's Master Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs,**
4 **Contract No. 1450CTH54T61071, in the total amount of \$249,876.24; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program expects to receive \$9,025.00 in matching funds**
6 **from the United States Geological Survey, pending execution of a joint funding**
7 **agreement; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program has proposed a budget amendment in fiscal year**
9 **2001 in the amount of \$84,857 to augment its budget line items for Salaries, Fringe**
10 **Benefits, Communication Expense, Gas, Oil and Coolants, Supplies-Office, Program**
11 **Supplies, Lease and Rentals, R & M Equipment, R & M Vehicles, Consumables, Non-**
12 **Major Capital Equipment, and Indirect Cost; and**

13 **WHEREAS, this budget amendment and savings proposal has been reviewed by the Water**
14 **Resources Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee and is recommended**
15 **for approval by the Legislative Council.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the**
17 **carryover of savings of Bureau of Indian Affairs funds provided by the Nation's Master**
18 **Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Contract No. 1450CTH54T61071, for the**
19 **Water Resources Study Program in the total amount of \$84,857.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the budget amendment of \$84,857 for the Water Resources Study**
21 **Program in fiscal year 2001 is approved in accordance with the budget amendment**
22 **attached hereto.**

29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**


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


