14		Legislative Council to issue its certification of election if a majority of the votes cast
15		is in favor of the referendum; and

20		possession and consumption of spirituous liquor within the exterior boundaries of
21		Hickiwan District in accordance with the Alcoholic Beverages Licensing and Control
22		Ordinance of the Tohono O'odham Nation.
