

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Certifying Results of Liquor Referendum in Hickiwan District)**

RESOLUTION NO. 01-305

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation enacted Ordinance 05-82, the Alcoholic Beverages**
2 **Licensing And Control Ordinance (Liquor Ordinance) in 1982; and**

3 **WHEREAS, Article 1, Section 4 (B) of the Liquor Ordinance empowers the Districts to sanction the**
4 **introduction, sale, possession and consumption of spirituous liquor within the**
5 **District through a referendum vote; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District did on Saturday, May 26, 2001 conduct a referendum vote**
7 **regarding the introduction, sale, possession and consumption of spirituous liquor**
8 **within the exterior boundaries of the Hickiwan District in conformity with the Liquor**
9 **Ordinance; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Election Board did issue and post its Certificate of Election Results in accordance**
11 **with Section 6 (K) of Article VII of the Uniform Election Ordinance regarding the**
12 **results of the liquor referendum vote; and**

13 **WHEREAS, Article 1, Section 4 (B) of the Liquor Ordinance requires the Tohono O'odham**
14 **Legislative Council to issue its certification of election if a majority of the votes cast**
15 **is in favor of the referendum; and**

16 **WHEREAS, of the total number of votes (160) 102 voted Yes and 58 voted No.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairwoman and Secretary of the Tohono O'odham**
18 **Legislative Council are hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the Council to**
19 **execute and deliver a Certificate of Election sanctioning the introduction, sale,**
20 **possession and consumption of spirituous liquor within the exterior boundaries of**
21 **Hickiwan District in accordance with the Alcoholic Beverages Licensing and Control**
22 **Ordinance of the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
24 **of JUNE, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,557.8 FOR; 699.0**
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 160.7 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
26 **Section 1 (g) of Article VI and Section 7 of Article X of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham**
27 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
28 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16**
29 **of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


