

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing Funding for the Arizona Indian Gaming Association's Advertising  
Campaign in Response to the Anti-Indian Gaming Campaign)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-322**

1 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Indian Gaming Association ("AIGA") is an association of tribal**  
2 **governments in Arizona that have gaming operations; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the AIGA represents the interests of TOGA and the Tohono O'odham Nation before**  
4 **local, State and federal governments, and other industry and trade associations; and**

5 **WHEREAS, American Greyhound Racing, Inc. has filed a lawsuit against Jane Dee Hull, Governor**  
6 **of Arizona (Case No. CV2000-020675) which claim, among other things, that the**  
7 **"making of an IGRA gaming compact is a legislative act beyond the executive**  
8 **authority of the Governor," and seeks to prevent the Governor from entering "into**  
9 **any new, modified, or renewed compacts purporting to allow slot machine, keno, or**  
10 **black jack gaming"; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the horse and dog tracks have launched a comprehensive campaign, utilizing**  
12 **advertising, public relations and lobbyists, that seeks to further the same goals as the**  
13 **law suit filed by American Greyhound Racing, Inc.; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Nation and other Arizona tribes have been in negotiations with the Governor to**  
15 **draft a new compact; and**

16 **WHEREAS, these activities represent a direct threat to the very gaming operations that occur on**  
17 **the Nation's lands that in turn fund such desperately needed projects such as the**  
18 **Nation's health clinic; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the AIGA has undertaken a responsive advertising and public relations campaign**  
20 **and has requested a percentage of funds from each tribe in Arizona of the net win for**  
21 **the Fiscal Year. The Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority has identified an amount of**  
22 **\$285,000.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby directs**  
24 **the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority to remit payment in the amount of \$285,000**  
25 **to fund the AIGA Responsive Advertising and Public Relations Campaign.**
