RESOLUTION NO. 01-328

1 **WHEREAS, the funding amount for the Department of Labor Supplemental Youth Services**
2 **Budget Program Year 2001 is \$164,928.00; and**

3 **WHEREAS, this budget is included in the program Comprehensive Service Plan which will**
4 **commence upon approval of this resolution and will expire June 30, 2004; and**


5 **WHEREAS, the reclassification of employment & training counselors and resource specialist has**
6 **been changed to case managers.**

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does hereby**
8 **approve the Department of Labor – Supplemental Youth Services Program Year 2001**
9 **Budget authorized for expenditure from the date of approval of this resolution until**
10 **June 30, 2004 in the amount of \$164,928.00.**

11 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
12 **Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairman is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute**
13 **the contract, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding or**
14 **funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this**
15 **Council.**

17 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 25TH. Day**
18 **of JUNE, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,337.15 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
19 **80.35 NOT VOTING; and [0] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f)**
20 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
21 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
22 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
