

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 2002 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program - Budget and Proposal)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-341**

1 **WHEREAS, Low Income Home Energy assistance funds have been made available to the Tohono**  
2 **O'odham Nation for FY 2002 through the State of Arizona, Department of Commerce;**  
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does meet the eligibility requirements to operate a Low**  
5 **Income Home Energy Assistance Program; and**

6 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to apply for FY 2002 Low**  
7 **Income Home Energy Assistance funds to assist eligible families with utility**  
8 **assistance; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to secure funding for provision of services**  
10 **during fiscal year 2002; and**


11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services has submitted for review and**  
12 **approval a scope of work and budget that will conform to the eligibility criteria set**  
13 **forth in the funding and reporting regulations.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 15 **1. That it does hereby authorize the officials of the Tohono O'odham Nation to**  
16 **submit a request for Low Income Home Energy Assistance Funding from the State**  
17 **of Arizona, Department of Commerce and authorizes expenditures in accordance**  
18 **to the attached budget.**
- 19 **2. That the duration of the contract shall be from July 01, 2001 through June 30,**  
20 **2002.**
- 21 **3. That the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the**  
22 **interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed grant has**  
23 **been approved by the United States Department of Commerce.**
- 24 **4. That the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice-Chairman**  
25 **and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the**  
26 **grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding**  
27 **levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 25<sup>TH</sup> Day  
2 of JUNE, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;  
3 -0- NOT VOTING; and [0] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of  
4 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
5 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
6 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


